The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) is seeking Statements of Qualifications to procure Geotechnical Site Investigation Services in the Silicon Valley to Central Valley Line. The RFQ is for a three-year contract that will ultimately be awarded to the most qualified Offeror at fair and reasonable compensation with a not-to-exceed amount of \$28 million. The estimate covers work along approximately 113 miles from San Jose to Gilroy, through the Pacheco Pass into the San Joaquin Valley to Madera.

The scope of work includes drilling, trenching, laboratory and field testing, geophysical surveys and associated permits, traffic control, spoils handling, hazardous materials assessments, seismic analysis, assessment of tunneling conditions, foundations analysis, water table analysis, slope stabilization, subsurface investigation plan, and preparation of geotechnical data and fault crossing displacement reports.
